June 29, Monday, Day 1: DEPART FROM USA

We depart from New York/JFK International Airport on an overnight flight to Paris. Dinner and breakfast will be served on the flight. Quotes for add-on flights, optional Premium Economy and Business Class prices are available upon request. We work with group airfares, which do not permit seat selection. If you wish to reserve specific seats on the flights, we recommend purchasing your own airline ticket and the land-only option with us.

June 30, Tuesday, Day 2: PARIS – LISIEUX

We arrive in Paris, France, to be greeted by Select International Tours' English-speaking tour manager, who will accompany us for the entire trip. We board our motorcoach for a two-hour bus ride to Lisieux. Upon arrival, we visit the home of St. Therese the Little Flower. We visit the Carmel Convent, where we celebrate Mass, and Les Buisonnets, the humble dwelling of the Saint. We see the magnificent Basilica of St. Therese and the Crypt before our hotel check-in. We settle into our rooms, enjoy dinner, and have a well-deserved night of rest in Lisieux. (D)

July 1, Wednesday, Day 3: NORMANDY BEACHES

We drive through the beautiful French countryside en route to the Normandy Beaches. The 54 miles of Atlantic stretching from Utah Beach in the west to Sword Beach in the east — are littered with WWII museums, monuments, cemeteries, and battle remains left in tribute to the courage of the British, Canadian, and American armies that successfully carried out the largest military operation in history: D-Day. On these serene beaches, at the crack of dawn on June 6, 1944, the Allies finally gained a foothold in France; from this moment, Nazi Europe was destined to crumble. This morning, we drive through beautiful Normandy scenery toward Omaha Beach, where we see the American Memorial and Cemetery. We celebrate Mass near Omaha Beach and

remember our brave, fallen soldiers. We return to Lisieux for dinner and an overnight stay. (B.D)

July 2, Thursday, Day 4: ROUEN - PARIS

After breakfast, we drive to Paris, stopping first in Rouen, where we retrace the footsteps of St. Joan of Arc. Rouen offers a restored medieval quarter and a magnificent Gothic cathedral, Notre-Dame, often painted by Claude Monet. Throughout its turbulent history, the city was destroyed several times. During the Middle Ages, it was devastated by fire and the plague. The English occupied it during the Hundred Years' War when the French heroine Joan of Arc (Jeanne d'Arc) was tried for heresy and burned at the stake in the central square in 1431. During WWII, Allied bombing raids laid waste to large parts of the city, especially the area south of the cathedral. Still, the city has undergone meticulous rebuilding over the last six decades. We tour the city on foot, celebrate Mass at the Church of St. Joan of Arc, and see where she was brutally murdered. We have lunch at La Couronne, the restaurant where Julia Child had such a fantastic meal that she decided to become a chef. After lunch, we continue to Paris, where we settle into our hotel. Dinner is at leisure tonight with the opportunity to explore Parisian cafe food. Overnight in Paris. (B. Special lunch)

July 3, Friday, Day 5: PARIS

After breakfast, we embark on a city tour of Paris, followed by a visit to the newly rebuilt Notre-Dame Cathedral, Paris' most beloved church. We continue to the Montmartre section of Paris to explore the city's Bohemian quarter and the magnificent Sacre Coeur (Sacred Heart Basilica), where we celebrate Mass. Tonight we see the light show at the Eiffel Tower from the upper deck of the ship or the lounge. Dinner will be served on the ship. We enjoy seeing Paris at night. Overnight in Paris. (B. Special dinner on the Seine River cruise)

July 4, Saturday, Day 6: PARIS AT LEISURE

Following morning Mass, we have a day at leisure to explore the city independently. We may want to visit one of the city's many museums, like the Louvre (be sure to purchase your tickets online well in advance), see St. Chapelle with its incredible stained glass windows, explore one of the famous areas of the city, or enjoy a nice meal while people-watching, a favorite Parisian pastime. Dinner is on our own tonight. Overnight in Paris. (B)

July 5, Sunday, Day 7: LOURDES

This morning, we celebrate Mass at the Chapel of the Miraculous Medal and see the incorrupt body of St. Vincent de Paul in the chapel of Maison-Mere before we take the TGV train to Lourdes. Upon arrival in Lourdes, we are transferred to our hotel. Following dinner, we join pilgrims from all over the world for the Candlelight Procession. Overnight in Lourdes. (B.D)

July 6, Monday, Day 8: LOURDES

We celebrate Mass, visit the Basilica and the Grotto, where Our Lady appeared to Bernadette, and drink water from the miraculous spring

that has been a source of healing for many. Our group will have the opportunity to visit Boly Mill, the birthplace of St. Bernadette, and the "Cachot," an abandoned prison where Bernadette's impoverished family once lived. We will also pray the Stations of the Cross and attend the Blessing of the Sick in the afternoon. Dinner and overnight in Lourdes. (B.D)

July 7, Tuesday, Day 9: LOURDES

After breakfast, we celebrate Mass, followed by a full day of prayer and devotion. We visit the baths, immerse ourselves in the miraculous water, and browse for religious gifts. In the evening, we join the Candlelight Procession. Dinner and overnight in Lourdes. (B.D)

July 8, Wednesday, Day 10: TOULOUSE

Following Mass in Lourdes, we depart for Toulouse, where Dominic of Osma founded the Dominican Order. The Jacobin Church was the heart of life and a teaching center in the 12th century, and now it is the place where St. Thomas Aquinas is buried. Standing majestically in the city's heart, the massive Gothic structure contains the tomb and the saint's relics. We have a guided tour of the church. Tonight's dinner is at a local restaurant, where we can choose from a selection of beer or wine. Dinner and overnight in Toulouse. (B. Special dinner)

July 9, Thursday, Day 11: RETURN TO USA

After breakfast, we are transferred to the airport for our flight home. (B)





PILGRIMAGE PRICES: Trip price is based on a minimum of 20 passengers. Prices may be adjusted for fewer travelers, changes in currency conversion rates, or amendments in local government taxes and/or fuel surcharges. Prices for this trip are in US dollars. For European travel, an exchange rate of US \$1.18 per Euro is assumed. *A late payment fee of \$100.00 per person will be charged for all payments received after the final payment due date.

SOLO TRAVEL: A limited number of single rooms are available. Prices are based on two people per room. We do not guarantee roommates, but will do our best to connect you with someone willing to share.

LAND-ONLY OPTION: Land-only services start and end at the hotels and do not include any airfare. You are welcome to transfer from the airport with the group if you arrive at the same time; otherwise, transfers are not included.

TOUR CANCELLATION POLICY: Individual deposits are refundable except for a \$350.00 per person handling fee for cancellations made 91 days or more before departure. A \$500.00 non-refundable fee will be assessed if the reservation is canceled between 90 and 60 days prior to departure. Within 60 days of departure, all payments are non-refundable regardless of the reason for cancellation. All airline tickets are non-refundable once issued. All cancellations must be in writing. Unused portions of the trip are not refundable. If a roommate cancels, the cost of a solo supplement will be added to your invoice. You may be eligible for a refund through your travel protection provider.

TRIP CANCELLATION PROTECTION: We strongly recommend the purchase of trip cancellation/travel accident insurance for every passenger to protect their investment (all payments are non-refundable 60 days before departure). PLEASE NOTE that in most cases travel protection must be purchased within 14 days. Additionally, some options are not available to residents of NY. AIRLINE, SEATING AND CHANGES: To best accommodate our pilgrims, we utilize Group Air Reservations. This affords more predictable space and pricing. However, the airline (not Select International Tours) assigns seats when the group tickets are issued. If you require very specific seats, we suggest you take advantage of the "Land Only" option and book your own airfare. Airline ticket name changes due to missing, incorrect, or incomplete information provided during registration will result in fees of at least \$350 per traveler. Switching reservations from Air and Land to Land Only within 100 days of departure will incur a minimum fee of \$150.00 per person. Quotes for Business class and Premium Coach seats are available upon written request, as are add-ons from your hometown airport.

SPECIAL NEEDS AND REQUESTS: All special needs and requests due to medical or dietary restrictions must be received in writing at least 60 days before departure. People needing a wheelchair should bring their own and travel with a companion who can provide care for them.

WALKING: Our trips require daily walking, (typically 12 to 15,000 steps) sometimes up or down slopes, steps, and uneven terrain. We recommend preparing by walking before the trip. A qualified and physically able travel companion must accompany anyone needing assistance. We are not responsible for any medical condition that occurs before, during, or after the trip.
